Action Pistol / All Steel Action Shoots

New targets + New scenarios = Unbelievable FUN!!

If you would like to learn how to shoot in competition, please join us for an exciting 2010 Action Pistol season. We draw a wide range of competitors, from beginners to seasoned veterans and everyone has a good time. Our matches begin at 6:00 PM at the CCKC Rifle Range. Each match is an individual competition so join us for whichever match date you can make. The only person you are competing against is yourself. The match fees are still \$10 for CCKC members and \$15 for non-members, this is a super shooting bargain in these lukewarm economic times.

2010 Action Pistol Match Dates

Wednesday AP dates are: May 12 and 26, June 9, September 1, 15 and 29.

Thursday AP dates are: June 17 and 24, July 15 and 29, August 12 and 26.

The Action Pistol matches are an introduction to the sport of USPSA competitive shooting. We utilize safe gun handling principles to help you improve your handgun skills. You will shoot timed match scenarios that require you to move and engage a wide range of reactive and static targets. Most participants shoot stock factory semi-auto handguns or pistol caliber rifle. Bring a belt holster, four magazines, and a minimum of 100 rounds of ammunition (no magnum loads). **WAIT A MINUTE:** You say the high price of ammo and equipment is keeping you from shooting? Continuing in 2010 is the .22LR match. From May through August the first match of the month will be .22LR neutral - meaning you can break out your .22 pistol or rifle and shoot the entire match. AP continues to be a fantastic shooting bargain. We have a new series of range props and targets for 2010 - so come on out!

2010 All Steel Action Match Dates.

Wednesday steel dates are: April 28, October 13 and 27.

The All Steel Action matches require you to engage steel reactive targets. You can shoot this match with a handgun, shotgun, pistol caliber rifle or a combination thereof. Bring at least 50 shot shells (#6 LEAD shot or smaller) and/or at least 100 rounds of pistol ammunition with you. These all steel matches continue to be very popular!

SAFETY- Our number one priority

We run a **COLD RANGE** - meaning that firearms must remain cased until the shooter is called to the start position. This procedure keeps everyone safely behind the line of fire. Eye and ear protection is mandatory for competitors and spectators alike. We welcome junior shooters (12 -18 years of age) who are accompanied by a participating parent and have the experience, knowledge, and attitude necessary to safely handle a firearm.

Weather Cancellations:

The Action Pistol/ All Steel Action matches are held outdoors, so remember to bring bug spray, sunscreen, water etc. as necessary. If the weather looks questionable call the CCKC office (262 857-7200) between 4:00pm and 5:00pm to check on match status for that day.
