



## **CCKC 2010 Fall Trap League Information and Rules**

### **It is the responsibility of each shooter to read and comply with league rules**

The Fall Trap League will run 10 weeks beginning Tuesday, August 31<sup>st</sup> and ending on Tuesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Teams will shoot on Tuesdays. If we get more teams than can be handled on Tuesdays, we will also shoot on Thursdays. The league will shoot 50 birds a week, all from the 16 yard line.

League fees will be \$125.00 per person for members of CCKC and \$150.00 per person for non-members. **Fees must be paid in full prior to shooting week 2 of the league.** Team members failing to pay prior to week 2 will not be allowed to shoot until league fees are paid.

#### **Shooting ahead will be allowed.**

Make-ups may be made any Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday during normal hours the Shotgun Range is open. Make-ups must be shot on the same trap as assigned for the day missed. Please inform the counter person of your team name, team number and your assigned trap house. All make-ups must be completed prior to 4:00pm, Sunday, Nov 7<sup>th</sup>.

A, B, C, Classes will be classified after 3 weeks of shooting if we have enough teams. We need at least 10 teams to have A and B classes and 15 teams for A, B and C classes.

Fees include: shooting 50 birds a week, trophies for the winners and a league dinner. The league awards and pizza gathering will be announced at a later date.

If you wish to shoot in the league and do not have a team or full team, please let us know and we will try to find a team for you or another shooter to fill your team.

All range rules must be followed. Only # 8 or #7 1/2 target shells may be used. Safety glasses and hearing protection are required. All empty hulls must be picked up.

Watch in the near future for an announcement concerning the Polar Bear League which will consist of shooting one round of 16 yards, one round of slider and possibly a week or two of skeet thrown in just to keep everyone honest. Suggestions will be taken at the Summer Trap League Dinner for this league.

Historically, the Polar Bear League is an individual league and not a team event.
