Capital improvements that have been made in this past year include: While there was not many major improvements done this year, there was a significant amount of money put back in our investment portfolio. Some time in the near future we will be closing on the thirty seven acres down range of the rifle range. This will create a additional buffer for the rifle range.

Rifle Range: A new gas furnace with ductwork was installed in the rifle side of the rifle range. This past year both pistol and rifle areas will have sprayed insulation applied. This year the fifty yard target area will get a new sidewalk and new steel target holders. The berms will also be groomed and drainage addressed.

Shotgun Range: A new lawn tractor was purchased. This is the 8th year for the high school trap league. They have won various awards. The wall between trap one and two will be removed and the five stand is almost ready to go.

Black powder: The new 22 range is opened some issues have to be addressed but it looks good. The deck has been rebuilt and a fence added around it. Road repaired. General clean-up thanks to everyone that helped.

Clubhouse: Hunter safety classes and various other instructional classes were held.
