2024 BSA Rifle Shooting Merit Badge

Scouts are invited to the Conservation Club of Kenosha County, for BSA Rifle Merit Badge classes. The entire merit badge or any portion of the merit badge is available at 6pm on the third Monday of the month, May through October. If your Scout was not able to finish shooting his groups at summer camp or needs some help on the range, we have precision rifles and experienced instructors available. Scouts must be able to demonstrate basic rifle marksmanship to complete this merit badge.

Cost is \$10/night to cover bolt action 22lr rifles, ammunition and targets. There is a maximum of 16 positions open for each night. Scouts must bring their Firearm Safety Training card - if you do not have a FST card, the half hour training module will be taught at the beginning of class. We will shoot from a covered outdoor position on the Rifle Range, so dress for outdoor weather and mud. We will shoot rain or shine. Please bring your shooting glasses and hearing protection if you have it. A signed BSA permission slip is required for a scout to attend Rifle Merit Badge classes at CCKC. Scouts will need to bring their **BSA membership number** to complete the course paperwork.

NOTE: Firearm Safety Discipline is our first priority - Scouts will adhere to the NRA safety rules they have been taught. This event will focus primarily on the shooting portion (five groups of five shots) of the merit badge, but the entire RMB class will be taught. Multiple nights are usually required to complete the entire RMB.
