

CCKC Board Meeting minutes
September 12, 2016

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by President Stan Raciak at 7:00 pm at the main clubhouse.

ROLL CALL

In attendance were Stan Raciak, Paul Coleman, Karen Hartmann, Pete Monaghan, Dan Christensen, George Broecker, Denny Hartmann, Alex Modic, Tom Jacobs, Dan Lutka and Bob Von Cloedt. Sue D'Aloia, Jerry Lis, Dean Andersen, John Moesch and Al Seyler were excused.

MINUTES:

The minutes for August were presented and approved.

TREASURER:

Sue D'Aloia was excused. There were no questions or issues. Figures were about the same as last month

RIFLE PISTOL:

Stan Raciak- Business has been up actually quite busy. There are no issues.

AIR GUN RANGE:

Alex Modic –Everything going good. Range is about 85%. Seven shooters are going to Nationals. The club is sending two teams to SW Michigan. Alex will be attending.

ARCHERY RANGE:

Dave Darbro- Four good Sundays, four lousy Saturdays. Everything is peaceful.

SHOTGUN RANGE:

Bob Von Cloedt- No real problems. A little routine maintenance is needed. Last Saturday was a very good day.

BLACK POWDER:

Dan Christensen- We had a couple of good weekends. We have more and more nonmembers coming out to shoot. The deck is done. The 22 range is an ongoing project. Al Tesch reminded Dan that deposit slips must be filled out when making a deposit.

COWBOY:

George Broecker- Everything is going good. We had a SASS match on August 13 and 14 with 84 shooters. We had an NCOW match on August 21st. We had 13 shooters. We had a wild bunch shoot on September 4th. with 14 shooters. We had a SASS match on September 11 with 47 shooters participating.

On September 27th we hosted a boy scout event. They brought out about 150 shooters. They had 14 stations manned by NRA instructors. They are learning how to run a 22 match for the family. We are expecting the new 22 range to boost their membership.

For the new 22 range, the berm work will be done inhouse. The plan is for the range to be 35 to 40 feet wide, It will have 9 spots to shoot. Discussion whether to put a roof over it is still under debate. It would be a good project for the scouts. The scouts will help with the baffles, once the necessary trees are removed and everything is laid out. Suggestion of transplanting trees to preserve the wilderness atmosphere was made as well as requiring a RO to be on duty just for the 22 range.

OLD BUSINESS:

There is a hunter safety course scheduled for October 15th. Hopefully, we can get a NRA Instructor course for shotgun and pistol set up. The instructor courses would be made available to range officers at cost.

NEW BUSINESS:

Dave Darbro said that we need a larger machine to build the new berms for the 22 range. A weeks rental could run up to \$1800. A motion made by Denny Hartmann to give approval for up to \$1800.00 for the rental of earth moving equipment for the 22 range. 2nd by Dan Lutka. motion carried. Dave Darbro will check with the John Deere dealer.

Dave Darbro brought up the matter of cleaning the kitchen in the main clubhouse. Airgun will maintain the clubhouse from November to May, when they are indoors for the winter. Airgun will take care of things on Saturday and archery will take care of Sundays while they are inside. We also need some cooperation from the gun show. Everyone needs to help with maintaining the clubhouse. Dave was extremely upset and left the meeting.

A bid was presented to Stan Raciak for installation of a new furnace in the rifle range in the amount of \$2214.45. by Dan Christensen. A motion made by Bob Von Cloedt to accept this bid and replace the furnace at the rifle range. 2nd by Pete Monaghan. The motion carried.

Another bid was presented to the board to insulate the rifle side of the range and the ceiling in the pistol side where needed, in the amount of \$4500.00. A motion was made by Alex Modic to Accept the bid and do the insulation. 2nd by Tom Jacobs. The motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS (CONTINUED):

Stan Raciak asked for up to \$600 to purchase gas pipe for the furnaces and the water heater so that when the natural gas is brought in, we will be ready to change over. This will be used for all three furnaces and the water heater. A motion made by Denny Hartmann to purchase the pipe. 2nd by Bob Von Cloedt. The motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Dan Lutka and 2nd by Bob Von Cloedt. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45.
