The Conservation Club of Kenosha County is offering a Hunter Safety Course this September. This course has two parts, an on-line learning session requiring several hours followed by a field safety check on **Saturday Sept. 28th**. SO PLEASE REGISTER TODAY!

How do you join the class?

Register by contacting Paul Coleman (paul.coleman2@comcast.net) to reserve a space in the class and either send in your nonrefundable \$10.00 registration fee by check to the address below or pay via Venmo to @Paul-Coleman-63. The registration fee is used to offset the course expenses. You will then receive a data packet by email with the course logon instructions - then go online and take the hunter safety course if you need to complete it. Attend the Field Safety Testing day at the CCKC Clubhouse on Sept. 28, 2024 from 9AM – 3PM. If you complete your requirements you will receive your temporary permit on that day!

The On-Line Hunter Education class is for students with a working knowledge of firearm safety. Participants must be able to navigate the Internet and complete the several hours of online course materials prior to the Field Safety Testing on Sept. 28th. Young hunters should have a responsible mentor assisting them online.

Class size is limited to 30 students. We will post the class as full once we reach this number. This class will fill up rapidly – so please register today! The Field Day will be held rain or shine! We will be outside for some field safety activities so please dress appropriately. Please bring a bag lunch. Only those who pre-register will be eligible to participate in the field day testing.
