

# CCKC Board Minutes

August 11, 2025

## CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by the Vice President, Stan Raciak, at the main clubhouse.

## ATTENDANCE:

## MINUTES:

There was a motion to accept the July 2025 minutes, no changes required, by Pete Leone, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bob Tollman. The motion passed.

## FINANCIALS:

Dean Caselli: There were no unexpected expenses for July 2025, and all board approved expenses came in at or below the not to exceed amount approved at prior meetings. Work has been done to update depreciation schedules which are an input to our annual tax filing due in November. Our largest expenditures this month were Recob's Target Shop, West Bend Insurance, and Cliff Kamm Concrete

## RANGE REPORTS:

Air Gun: No Report (Alex Modic, HRO, excused)

Archery: Barb Johnson/Joe Richardson: We have had lower attendance, but are 5 weeks away from archery season in Wisconsin (so expected to pick up). We added 1 new Range Officer. We have 2 quotes for construction of the covered shooting positions, and 3 quotes for the concrete work. Met with the Village of Bristol inspector and there are no concerns--guided that we apply for a building permit when ready.

Rifle/Pistol: Bob Tollman: It was very hot this past weekend and it drove attendance down. The Garage project is coming along nicely.

Shotgun: No Report (Paul Coleman, HRO Proxy, excused)

Black Powder: Dan Christiansen: We were slow due to heat, only 1 person on Saturday. Sunday saw a few more on the .22 Range until rain. The mower approved by the board was purchased.

Cowboy Range: George Broecker: We had 26 shooters across Saturday and Sunday.

CORRESPONDENCE: None.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

Skid Steer: Denny Hartmann reports the skid steer is in the shop for standard maintenance for the next 1.5 weeks.

New Range Construction: The WDNR has approved up to 75% of costs, but not more than \$120K, for the construction of the new range (there are limits/stipulations)

POS System Implementation: Pete Leone reports that testing continues on the POS system and the touch screens at RPR, with a demonstration provided to RPR HROs. Stan requested more programming to make it as user friendly as possible. Members will receive new membership cards sent out in batches by mail (date TBD). If an existing member comes to a range without their new card, a POS look-up can be done. Both a member name and number will be printed on each card. To confirm identity, and eliminate card-sharing, cashiers will be required to check Driver's License, but CCKC will not capture DL information under any circumstances.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Wilmot H.S. Shooting Team Update: The team requested the use of the RPR on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 5pm to 9pm, January through August 2026, for training purposes at \$3,000; There was a motion made by Pete Leone to approve this request, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott Jackson. The motion passed. They have also received a \$50,000 grant from MidwayUSA to support their training. CCKC continues to be proud to be their primary training center, and we wish them continued success.

Storage Locker Rentals: The board discussed the 7 new rental lockers in the new garage at RPR (South side of building, exterior access), as well as the existing larger lockers in the RPR complex, and the pricing for these going forward. Two motions were made regarding pricing, as follows: There was a motion made by Jeff Lowry to charge \$250.00 each, per year, for the 7 new garage storage lockers, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott Jackson. The motion passed. There was a

motion made by Scott Jackson, to charge \$300.00 each, per year, for the existing larger storage lockers, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pete Leone. The motion passed.

The Current Membership stands at: 2,445

There was a motion made by Denny Hartmann, to adjourn the meeting, with a 2nd by Pete Leone. The motion passed.
