## MINUTES:

There was a motion to accept the December minutes by Scott Jackson 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pete Leone. The motion passed.

FINANCIALS: Dean Caselli: No unexpected expenses and all board approved expenses came in at or below the not to exceed the amount authorized. Our largest expenses for the month were Cliff Kamm concrete, Recob's Target shop and Chase Corporate Credit Card Monthly. The base is staying stable.

## RANGE REPORTS:

Air gun: Alex Modic: The berm has been increased by about 2 feet. We are shooting indoors at the main clubhouse. The league did a soft start in December.

Archery: Barb Johnson/Joe Richardson: We are in the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of our 3d league. We have about 70 shooters. We are getting new shooters from the internet and Facebook. A few have become new members, and we added a new RO. There was no issue on the non-member price increase. Sunday attendance is increasing.

Rifle: Bob Tollman: Things are slow, very slow. It's routine for it to be slow after the holidays.

The Upper range is basically all done except for the roof. Asphalt, a new gate and dirt etc. are still coming.

Shotgun: Paul Coleman had a three-hour meeting with Bill Lerch to discuss the operations at the range. They are looking to pursue a paid position, possibly a manager. Bill may have a suitable candidate. Bill's goal is to transition out by July, which is when the Central Falcons season ends. The range has been improved to the point that the

manager would just need to maintain things. The pay is yet to be determined. We will need to replace a couple of the trap machines. On the skeet field the curtains have been removed. Only #9 shot can be used on that range. We have 25 panels from the shot\_curtain being stored. The life span of the curtains has been better than anticipated.

Black Powder: Dan Christiansen: The range is closed.

Cowboy Range: George Broecker: The range is closed. 1<sup>st</sup> shoot is scheduled for April.

Old Business: The lumberjacks will be coming back in the Spring to continue the forest management.

New Business: Stan Raciak and Bob Tollman have determined that the upper rifle range will be available for commercial rental at the rate of \$500 per day. The new building will be available for \$250 per day.
