CALL TO ORDER:

MINUTES:

There was a motion to accept the December minutes by Pete Leone. 2nd by Scott Jackson. The motion passed.

FINANCIALS: Dean Caselli: No unexpected expenses and all board approved expenses came in at or below the not to exceed the amount authorized. Our largest expenses for the month were Cheney Subz (Roof New Range), MA landscaping (annual contract) and West Bend Insurance (quarterly payment). Investments are down slightly.

RANGE REPORTS:

Air gun: Alex Modic: Things are going well. Several archery shooters have started shooting with air gun on a fairly regular basis. We have a few good youth shooters coming up. My backup RO's did a good job in my absence.

Archery: Barb Johnson/Joe Richardson: The 3d league is over. We had a good turnout with 70 shooters participating. Sunday attendance is up. We have an outdoor cleanup planned, the creek is flowing, well below the bridge but unfortunately the beavers are back.

We have a meeting scheduled for next week with our contractors. We are hoping to get this project started at the end of March or the beginning of April.

Rifle: Bob Tollman: Things are picking up a little but still pretty slow. We have signed up a few new members and many renewals.

Shotgun: The fence between our range and the walking path needs to be replaced.

The driveway needs some attention. There are cracks that need to be fixed. We are contacting Cissini Paving for a quote. Also requesting a quote for the road up to the new range and for resurfacing at the rifle/pistol range. The Central Falcons are applying for a grant from Midway to replace 2 Pat traps and for two more in the future.

Black Powder: Dan Christiansen: The range is closed. Opening the first weekend of April.

Cowboy Range: George Broecker: The range is closed. Opening the first weekend in April.

Correspondence: none

Old Business: Dean Caselli and Pete Leone have been working on the POS system and membership database. They reviewed and provided feedback to Sean King at Cultivating digital. Additional requirements were reviewed. Sean will update the documents. Detailed requirements are a big job so it's important that we get what we want from the project. We will use the User Experience Narratives, the Architecture Proposal document etc to perform the deep dive. Sean is providing an 1.5-hour overview of Woo Commerce as a possible system of record for member data to support the POS system (and replace our current membership database) on 3/11. A deeper dive will also be conducted. Events = matches, leagues etc. There was a motion made by Alex Modic not to exceed \$1500 for an IT architectural review. 2nd by Jeff Lowry. The motion passed.

New Business: We need to make some changes to the Articles of Incorporation. Some of this can be done by the board. Section 2: A majority of the members present shall constitute a quorum.
