Our club is seeing less participation in the shooting sports. However, our financial position is solid and has been well managed by your Board of Directors. This financial foundation has been augmented by obtaining several grants from the WDNR and Midway to help finance the expansion of our shooting ranges. We have a training facility now at Rifle, Shotgun has new trap equipment, Airgun has a larger, safer berm, Archery and Wilderness will have improved shooting positions, we will resurface the asphalt parking lots at our club later this month – all of which is being done without having to take out construction loans. We experienced challenges in obtaining an electronic membership system that meets our needs and we are contracting software development to build a system tailored to our club. Another challenge we face is getting volunteers to help run our club. There are open positions for Shotgun management and Club Secretary that are critical to fill. Our club services the needs of our community by providing a training facility to over 24 law enforcement agencies. We have Shotgun Five Stand leagues, Action Pistol matches, NRA Rifle matches, Archery leagues, Air Gun matches, Cowboy SASS matches and Blackpowder events.
